Kissinger and Brzezinski teach Norwegians peace: Honoured by the Nobel Institute and Oslo University

It ought to be unthinkable: Alfred Nobel's award for reduction of militarism and for peace-making is misused to honour Henry Kissinger and Zbigniew Brzezinski.





In Orwellian style they will speak at Oslo University invited by the Nobel Institute about a theme they know nothing about and have done nothing to promote: World peace.

The Nobel Prize violators deal a slap in the face of any decent academic and anyone who cares about peace.

Free open debat? Yes, of course - let the 93 and the 88 year old speak at the University - voices of a dark past about a darker future?

But then, when will the true advocates, scholars and politicians for peace - Alfred Nobel's "champions of peace" - be invited and honoured?

Neither the Swedish Nobel Foundation nor legal authorities will lift a finger at this new violation of Nobel's will. We know that.

Anybody who feels they need to be enlightened by two of the oldest and worst representatives of the most militant and war-fighting nation on earth about world peace signals only one thing:

The intellectual and moral decay of a small Western country totally submissive to the US – which itself is in utterly clear moral, intellectual, political and economic decay – and Empire fast approaching its end thanks to its own policies.

Boycott the event or go there and ask all the questions. It's a free society with freedom of expression, isn't it? Demand that the champions of peace will be heard and that Alfred Nobel's will be respected.
